Pool Rules and Guidelines

Piquet Lane Swim Club has been a great place for children, for over 50 years. Our devotion to the safety of your children is an important part of how we manage the club. In the recent years, there has been a tremendous increase in the number of families with children. The pool has been experiencing an increase in its daily use. The lifeguards are working hard to keep the swimming pools safe for all members.

- The pool will open at 10am and will remain open until 8pm during the season. Both opening and closing times are subject to change without prior notice.
- Diving is permitted only in the diving area. General swimming is not permitted in the diving area.
- The swim area around the diving board must be free and clear of any other person, including parents.
- Children jumping into the arms of a parent is not permitted.
- Children who require the use of a floatation device **MUST** be accompanied into the pool by a parent or guardian. The parent or guardian must physically be **IN** the water and not standing on the ledge or sitting on the steps.
- Any child who is deemed at risk, due to the inattentiveness of a parent or guardian, may be removed from the pool.
- Any incidents (e.g. saves) must be reported to the Director.
- Any child who needed to be saved from the swimming pool must wait a minimum of 30 minutes before reentering the pool.
- Only **TWO** lounges per family are permitted.
- There is no running permitted around the deck of the pool.

- Children who are not “potty trained” are required to wear swim diapers in the pool. Swim diapers are usually available for purchase in the office.
- Admission to the pool may be refused to anyone at the discretion of the Director.
- Disobedience towards the lifeguards, Director, or Assistant Director can result in immediate removal from the pool area.
- Absolutely no glass containers of any kind are permitted in the pool area.

All guidelines stated above are subject to change upon the discretion of the management and Board of Directors.

Management reserves the right to make special need decisions on a case-by-case basis.
